

2022 YOUTH SAILOR GEAR LIST

- LIFEJACKET:** Each sailor will be required to wear a life jacket (PFD) each day while on the dock and while sailing. Life Jackets will be provided.
- Sailors are welcome to bring their own USCG approved lifejackets. Please label your child's personal life jacket with his/her name.
- SUN SAFETY:** Camp will be held outdoors, and on-the-water so be sure to follow common sun safety tips:
1. Use a sunscreen with a high SPF – please apply before camp.
Your sailor can bring sunblock from home if they can re-apply independently.
Instructors and staff may not apply or provide sunblock.
 2. Cover up with loose close weave clothing and a hat with a brim to protect neck, ears and face.
 3. Wear sunglasses
 4. Stay hydrated
- WATER:** Pack a full reusable water bottle. OCC provides water for re-fills.
- SNACK:** Sailors are requested to bring a snack each day. If perishable please pack with an ice pak.
- CLOTHING:** Sailors should wear weather appropriate, layered clothing that can get wet and/or dirty.
- FULL CHANGE OF CLOTHES:** All sailors should bring a change of clothes and a towel each day. Packing a plastic bag for wet clothing is a good idea.
- FOOTWEAR:** Closed toe shoes are required and should be suitable for walking on the boats. No black soled shoes, and no bare feet, sandals or open toed shoes.
- BACKPACK:** Help keep all your sailor's belongings together by packing them in a backpack.
- HAND SANITIZER:** Hand sanitizer are available on-site for your convenience.
- FACE COVERING:** Students, visitors and staff are required to wear a mask indoors. Masks are not required to be worn outside by participants, instructors and staff.
- ELECTRONICS:** Cell phones and water don't mix. Sailors should leave phones in their back packs before launching boats.
