

GET MATERIALS READY

- -Markers/Crayons
- -Scissors
- -Any kind of paper


-Tape



DECIDE WHAT PAPER YOU WILL USE

-You may use large pieces of construction paper. -You may use regular lined paper. -You may use plain white paper.

I used 2 large pieces of construction paper.

DRAW THE SHAPES YOU WANT FOR YOUR HOLES.

You may use items in shapes of circles to trace or you draw in your own shapes. I did circles, triangle & squares.





WRITE IN THE SCORES

Once you have drawn in your shapes, cut them out. Then you will add the scores to the score board. The smallest or more complicated will have a higher score.

5 HANG YOUR SCORING BOARD & MAKE A PAPER AIRPLANE

Once you are done, tape your scoring holes on a bar or anywhere where you will have open space behind it. I found a place in my backyard to tape it. Next, make your paper airplane. It does not have to be fancy.
