LUNCH, KIDS CAFE Kids Cafe provides free lunches and snacks at the Boys & Girls Club of Stanton. Teens can choose to take or not take the free lunches and free snacks provided. Teens may bring their own lunches if they want and refrigerate them in the Teen Center's refrigerator. The Teen Center does offer snacks and drinks to purchase. Teens are highly encouraged to bring their own lunches, snacks and drinks if they are not going to take the Club's free lunches or snacks.

TEEN FIELD TRIPS Teen Field Trips are OPTIONAL, Staff supervised, teen-orientated trips that are done during normal Club hours (unless otherwise noted). Teen Field Trips require fees/costs, Teen Program Hours/Club Service Hours, and permission slips in order for teens to attend. Please note, each Teen Field Trip may not include lunch or snacks, so please plan accordingly. Since there is limited space per field trip, it is FIRST COME, FIRST PAID. All Teen Program Hours/Club Service Hours must be completed by 8AM on the THURSDAY of the Teen Field Trip, otherwise that teen will be ineligible to attend that Teen Field Trip. There is a STRICT 24 Hour Cancellation Policy (you must give a 24 hour notice of cancellation), where failure to cancel within 24 hours results in a NON REFUND. Teen Field Trips are subject to change or cancellation due to attendance or other circumstances. The Teen Center is CLOSED during Teen Field Trip days (teens can participate in accumulating Club Service hours or other appropriate activities at the Club)

TEEN NIGHTS Teen Nights are OPTIONAL, Staff supervised, teen-orientated nights that are generally after normal Club hours. Depending on the Teen Night, there may be associated costs (ex food, activities) on top of the Teen Night fee. Please note permission slips will be needed for activities and/or events held on Teen Nights. Some Teen Nights may start earlier than 6PM and end later than 9PM, so please check the Teen Nights Schedule for more info. There is a STRICT 24 Hour Cancellation Policy (you must give a 24 hour notice of cancellation), where failure to cancel within 24 hours results in a NON REFUND. Teen Nights are subject to change or cancellation due to attendance or other circumstances.

TEEN PROGRAMS This summer's Teen Programs are: Teen Fitness, Keystone, Chef Affame, Sports League, Bowling League, Gauntlet of Games, Passport to Manhood, Teen Art Program and Social Rec. Some of these Teen Programs require fees (ex Teen Fitness, Bowling League) and some do not require fees (ex Keystone, Chef Affame, Sports League, Gauntlet of Games, Passport to Manhood, Teen Art Program and Social Rec).
